Overview

The Integrated Heritage Project's admissions process is holistic which means we weigh many factors and consider multiple qualifications of each candidate. We encourage you to use your recommendations, short answers, and essays to provide the most complete picture of yourself as a student and as a professional in the field of cultural heritage. Preference will be given to students who can demonstrate the capacity to think broadly about the issues facing cultural heritage – tangible and intangible - and apply their knowledge to solving practical problems faced by developing countries.

*The program will be taught in English. Applicants must demonstrate fluency in English.

- An official transcript from an accredited institution of higher education
- 1 letter of recommendation
- Completed application form

Please note

- Completed applications must be filed by midnight **March 31, 2018** by close of business US Eastern Standard Time (USA).
- Applicants will be notified by Friday **April 6th, 2018**.
- If accepted, a deposit of **USD \$1500** will be required by **April 15, 2018**. This payment will secure your space on the program. If payment is not received by this date, your place will be given to another student. Accepted students will be provided with the link to pay the deposit fee.
- Upon receipt of deposit, participants will receive full program details including itinerary, e-handbook, syllabus, and next steps for preparing for program participation.
